COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills required to safely operate working platforms, including mobile elevating work platforms (MEWPs) and scaffolding. It covers legal requirements, hazard identification, risk assessment, and safe operating procedures to prevent accidents and ensure compliance with South African health and safety legislation.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply relevant occupational health and safety legislation and regulations to working platform operations.
- Identify and assess hazards associated with working platform use, including stability, fall risks, and environmental factors.
- Demonstrate pre-operational inspections and safety checks on working platforms according to manufacturer specifications.
- Implement safe operating procedures for erecting, using, and dismantling working platforms.
- Evaluate emergency procedures and rescue plans for working platform incidents.
- Analyze incident reports and recommend corrective actions to improve working platform safety.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for operators, supervisors, and safety officers who use or oversee working platforms in construction, maintenance, warehousing, and industrial settings.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Working Platform Safety and Operation

- Overview of OHS Act, Construction Regulations, and SANS standards.
- Types of working platforms: scaffolding, mobile elevated work platforms (MEWPs), ladders, and temporary structures.
- Roles and responsibilities: operator, supervisor, and competent person.
- Pre-use inspections: structural integrity, safety devices, and load capacity.
- Fall protection systems: harnesses, lanyards, guardrails, and safety nets.
- Hazard identification: electrical, weather, ground conditions, and overhead obstructions.
- Safe access and egress: ladder safety, gate operation, and platform stability.
- Emergency planning: rescue procedures, first aid, and communication.

Day 2: Practical Operation and Advanced Safety Procedures

- Practical pre-use inspection checklist and logbook.
- MEWP controls: drive, lift, steer, and emergency stop.
- Safe maneuvering on site: slopes, uneven ground, and confined spaces.
- Load management: weight limits, personnel vs. material.
- Weather considerations: wind speed, lightning, and wet conditions.
- Communication with ground crew: hand signals and radios.
- Incident scenarios: entanglement, tip-over, and power line contact.
- Post-operation procedures: parking, charging, and shutdown.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
