- Agitation methods: brushing, scrubbing, and rotary tools
- Spot removal protocols: blotting, flushing, and extraction
- Specialised stain treatments: protein, tannin, oil-based
- Dealing with urine and odour removal
- Testing colourfastness before treatment

Day 4: Wet Extraction Procedures and Drying

- Proper wand technique: overlapping passes, speed control
- Solution temperature and pressure settings
- Recovery efficiency: minimising moisture left in carpet
- Drying equipment: air movers, dehumidifiers, extraction fans
- Drying time calculations and moisture monitoring
- Post-cleaning inspection: residue, spots, and overall appearance

Day 5: Advanced Applications and Business Practices

- Cleaning specialty carpets: delicate fibres and low-moisture methods
- Encapsulation and low-moisture alternatives
- Environmental compliance: waste water disposal, green chemicals
- Estimating job time and pricing
- Customer service: follow-up, warranties, and referrals
- Certification and continuing education opportunities
