COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Occupational Health, Safety, and Environmental Principles

- Overview of OHS legislation (OHSA, COIDA, NEMA)
- Key OHS definitions: hazard, risk, incident
- Roles and responsibilities of employers and employees
- Economic and social benefits of OHS

Day 2: Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (HIRA)

- Types of hazards: physical, chemical, biological, ergonomic, psychosocial
- Risk assessment process: identify, assess, control, review
- Risk matrix and prioritization
- Hierarchy of controls: elimination, substitution, engineering, administrative, PPE

Day 3: Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems

- ISO 45001 and OHSAS 18001 overview
- Policy development and management commitment
- Planning: objectives, resources, training
- Operational control and emergency preparedness

Day 4: Environmental Management Principles

- NEMA, waste management, air quality, water use acts
- Environmental aspects and impacts assessment
- Waste hierarchy: reduce, reuse, recycle, dispose
- Spill response and environmental monitoring

Day 5: Incident Investigation and Reporting

- Incident types: near miss, first aid, lost time, fatality
- Investigation process: gather evidence, interview, root cause analysis
- Reporting requirements and timelines
- CAPA (Corrective and Preventive Action) process

Day 6: Emergency Preparedness and Response

- Types of emergencies: fire, chemical spill, medical, natural disasters
- Emergency response team roles
- Evacuation procedures and assembly points
- Drill planning, execution, and evaluation

Day 7: Integration, Audit, and Continuous Improvement

- Internal auditing process: checklist, interviews, reporting
- Management review and performance indicators
- Behavior-based safety and employee engagement
- Action planning for continuous improvement

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
