This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills to identify and mitigate workplace safety, security, and environmental hazards. It focuses on recognizing potential risks, implementing preventive measures, and ensuring compliance with South African health and safety legislation. By the end of the course, participants will be able to contribute to a safer and more secure work environment.

- Identify potential safety, security, and environmental hazards in the workplace.
- Apply appropriate methods to assess and prioritize risks associated with identified hazards.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for employees, supervisors, and safety representatives in any industry who are responsible for maintaining workplace safety and security.
- It is also suitable for individuals seeking to enhance their understanding of hazard identification and risk assessment.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundational Concepts of Workplace Hazards

- Introduction to workplace safety, security, and environmental management.
- Overview of the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Act and related regulations.
- Hazard categories and examples.
- Rights and duties of employees and employers.
- Basic hazard identification techniques: observation and checklists.
- Introduction to risk assessment principles.
- Consequences of neglecting hazard identification.
- Case study: common workplace hazards.

Day 2: Hazard Identification Techniques and Risk Assessment

- Job Safety Analysis (JSA) and workplace inspections.
- Risk assessment process: identify, analyse, evaluate, control.
- Using a risk matrix: likelihood vs. severity.
- Security hazard identification: access control, suspicious behaviour, emergency procedures.
- Environmental hazard identification: chemical storage, waste disposal, pollution.
- Hazard reporting forms and communication protocols.
- Hierarchy of controls: elimination, substitution, engineering, administrative, PPE.
- Practical exercise: conducting a mock inspection.

Day 3: Integration, Emergency Response, and Continuous Improvement

- Emergency response plans: fire, chemical spill, medical, security threats.
- Incident reporting and investigation basics.
- Root cause analysis techniques (e.g., 5 Whys).
- Safety culture and employee participation.
- Continuous improvement: inspections, audits, and feedback loops.
- Review of case studies and lessons learned.
- Personal action plan for applying knowledge at work.
- Assessment and course wrap-up.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 1**.
