It focuses on identifying hazards, assessing risks, and applying appropriate emergency response actions to ensure personnel safety and regulatory compliance.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply hazard identification and risk assessment techniques to workplace scenarios.
- Implement emergency response plans, including evacuation and first aid procedures.
- Demonstrate the use of safety and survival equipment such as fire extinguishers and personal protective gear.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of emergency drills and recommend improvements.
- Analyze incident reports to identify root causes and preventive measures.
- Design a basic emergency preparedness plan for a specific work area.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for safety officers, team leaders, supervisors, and any employees responsible for implementing or overseeing emergency procedures in high-risk environments such as manufacturing, mining, construction, and industrial settings.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Safety, Survival and Emergency Procedures

- Overview of safety, survival and emergency procedures.
- Legal framework: OHS Act, regulations and SAQA requirements.
- Hazard identification and risk assessment principles.
- Emergency response team roles and responsibilities.
- Communication protocols during emergencies.

Day 2: Emergency Planning and Risk Assessment

- Components of an emergency action plan.
- Risk assessment methodologies.
- Emergency resource inventory: fire extinguishers, first aid kits, alarms.
- Hierarchy of controls: elimination, substitution, engineering, administrative, PPE.
- Case study: risk assessment in a typical workplace.

Day 3: Fire Safety and Fire Fighting Procedures

- Fire triangle and classes of fire.
- Types of fire extinguishers and their use.
- Fire detection and alarm systems.
- Evacuation routes and assembly points.
- Practical: fire extinguisher operation and evacuation drill.

Day 4: First Aid and Medical Emergencies

- Basic first aid principles and scene safety.
- Primary survey (DRABC) and secondary survey.
- Management of bleeding, fractures, burns and shock.
- CPR and AED operation.
- First aid kit contents and maintenance.

Day 5: Survival Techniques and Hazardous Material Incidents

- Survival principles: shelter, water, signaling.
- Hazardous materials classification and labelling.
- Safety data sheets (SDS) interpretation.
- Spill containment and decontamination procedures.
- PPE selection, inspection and use.

Day 6: Integration, Assessment and Continuous Improvement

- Scenario-based integrated emergency drill.
- Debriefing and performance evaluation.
- Incident reporting and documentation.
- Continuous improvement: plan-do-check-act cycle.
- Final assessment and course review.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **9 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 3**.
