COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the skills to safely and efficiently operate a cane feeder table in a sugar processing environment. Participants will understand the mechanical and operational principles of the feeder table, enabling them to monitor and control the flow of cane into the milling process while adhering to safety protocols.

- Demonstrate the correct start-up, operation, and shut-down procedures for a cane feeder table.
- Apply safety protocols and identify hazards associated with cane feeder table operations.
- Monitor and adjust feeder table speed and cane flow to optimize milling efficiency.
- Perform routine inspections and basic maintenance on feeder table components.
- Interpret operational indicators and respond to abnormal conditions or alarms.
- Document operational data and report deviations according to standard procedures.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for process operators, shift supervisors, and maintenance personnel working in sugar mills or related agro-processing facilities who are responsible for cane feeder table operations.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Cane Feeder Table Operation Fundamentals

- Overview of sugar milling process and role of feeder table
- Key components: conveyor belts, drive systems, controls, and safety devices
- Pre-start inspection checklist: mechanical, electrical, and housekeeping
- Start-up sequence: interlocks, alarms, and normal operating parameters
- Monitoring techniques: flow rate, jam detection, and load management
- Common operational problems: chokes, spillage, and belt misalignment
- Shutdown procedures: normal and emergency stops
- Housekeeping and basic maintenance awareness

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
