- Designing a heritage management plan: steps and components.
- Economic sustainability: tourism, funding, and enterprise development.
- Social sustainability: inclusivity, education, and cultural vitality.
- Environmental sustainability: green practices in heritage sites.
- Monitoring and evaluation: indicators and reporting.
- Workshop: creating a mini heritage management plan in groups.
- Presentation of plans and peer feedback.
- Final assessment and certification guidance.
