- Verification techniques: environmental sampling, satellite imagery, and data analysis
- Role of export controls and the Nuclear Suppliers Group
- Emerging challenges: cyber threats, AI, and dual-use technologies
- Disarmament verification: lessons from bilateral and multilateral agreements
- Practical workshop: mock review exercise or scenario analysis
- The role of civil society and media in disarmament advocacy
- Future outlook: next steps for the NPT and the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons
