This course equips healthcare professionals with advanced phlebotomy skills beyond basic venipuncture, focusing on specialised procedures for complex patient populations. It covers techniques for difficult venous access, paediatric and geriatric patients, and special collection requirements to ensure accurate diagnostic results and patient safety.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply advanced venipuncture techniques for patients with difficult venous access, including using ultrasound guidance.
- Implement age-specific phlebotomy protocols for paediatric, geriatric, and neonatal patients.
- Evaluate special collection requirements for blood cultures, coagulation studies, and therapeutic drug monitoring.
- Demonstrate proper infection control and safety measures during specialised phlebotomy procedures.
- Analyze complications related to phlebotomy and implement corrective actions to minimise patient risk.
- Design a quality assurance plan for phlebotomy services to ensure specimen integrity and patient satisfaction.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This training is designed for registered nurses, clinical technologists, and phlebotomists who already possess foundational phlebotomy skills and seek to expand their expertise in specialised procedures within hospital, clinic, or laboratory settings.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundational Principles and Practical Application of Specialised Phlebotomy

- Introduction to specialised phlebotomy: scope, ethical considerations, and SAQA unit standard requirements.
- Legal and regulatory framework: HPCSA guidelines, patient consent, and documentation.
- Equipment selection and preparation: butterfly needles, safety devices, and specialised tubes.
- Techniques for difficult venous access: vein location, warming, and alternative sites.
- Blood culture collection: aseptic technique, timing, and volume requirements.
- Arterial puncture for blood gas analysis: indications, radial artery technique, and post-procedure care.
- Capillary sampling: heel prick in neonates and fingerstick in adults.
- Infection prevention and control: hand hygiene, sharps disposal, and spill management.
- Complication management: haematoma, nerve injury, syncope, and allergic reactions.
- Practical demonstration and hands-on practice with mannequins and peer simulation.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
