COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Medical Pathology and Blood Transfusion Procedures

- Introduction to medical pathology and blood transfusion services.\n• Occupational health and safety standards (including PPE, waste management).\n• Overview of blood components and their clinical uses.\n• Blood group systems (ABO and Rh) and compatibility testing.\n• Specimen collection techniques (venipuncture, capillary sampling).\n• Handling, labelling, and transportation of blood samples.\n• Pre-transfusion testing: cross-matching and antibody screening.\n• Transfusion reactions: types, signs, and immediate management.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
