Day 1: Foundations of Mission Health, Safety, and Security Management

- Introduction to Mission Health, Safety, and Security (HSS) Management
- Legal framework: OHSA, SANS standards, and relevant legislation
- Hazard identification and risk assessment (HIRA) fundamentals
- Security threats and vulnerability analysis in mission environments
- Emergency preparedness and response planning
- Roles and responsibilities of mission personnel in HSS
- Incident reporting and documentation procedures
- Practical exercise: Conducting a basic risk assessment for a typical mission activity
