Day 1: Foundations of Fleet Integration

- Introduction to fleet management and integration concepts.
- Overview of relevant legislation (OHSA, NOSA, SAQA unit standards).
- The business case for integration: cost, safety, and productivity.
- Stakeholder identification and communication protocols.
- Principles of asset lifecycle management.
- Risk management fundamentals in fleet operations.

Day 2: Technical Specifications and Pre-Operational Planning

- Analysing manufacturer documentation and specifications.
- Compliance verification against South African standards.
- Developing checklists for pre-commissioning inspections.
- Planning for site readiness (space, utilities, access).
- Resource allocation for integration (personnel, tools, budget).
- Introduction to telematics and fleet management software.

Day 3: Operational Implementation and Training

- Step-by-step commissioning and acceptance protocols.
- Designing competency-based training for operators and technicians.
- Updating maintenance plans and schedules (preventive, predictive).
- Data capture and KPI establishment for new equipment.
- Change management strategies for operational teams.
- Safety induction and procedure updates specific to new assets.

Day 4: Performance Optimisation and Continuous Improvement

- Interpreting performance data and telematics reports.
- Root cause analysis for underperformance or integration issues.
- Optimising utilisation and scheduling for maximum ROI.
- Planning for end-of-life: disposal, trade-in, or refurbishment.
- Documentation and reporting requirements for SAQA alignment.
- Course review, assessment preparation, and action planning.
