- Types of stock and their handling requirements.
- Cleaning equipment, tools, and chemicals: selection and use.
- Step-by-step cleaning procedures for various stock types.
- Health and safety regulations (OHS Act) and personal protective equipment.
- Waste disposal and environmental considerations.
- Documentation and record-keeping for cleaning activities.

Day 2: Advanced Techniques and Practical Application

- Preventive maintenance planning and scheduling.
- Troubleshooting cleaning equipment and chemical issues.
- Quality control: inspection techniques and standards.
- Corrective actions for non-compliance.
- Continuous improvement: feedback and process optimization.
- Practical session: hands-on cleaning and maintenance tasks.
- Assessment and evaluation of cleaning procedures.
- Final review and certification requirements.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
