WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for individuals seeking to deepen their understanding of theological concepts and apply them in real-world contexts, including religious leaders, educators, and community workers.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Theological Information and Contextual Interpretation

- What is theological information?
- Sources of theological information: scripture, tradition, reason, experience.
- The concept of context: historical, cultural, social, and personal.
- Introduction to hermeneutics: principles of interpretation.
- Genres of theological texts: narrative, poetry, prophecy, epistle, apocalyptic.

Day 2: Historical and Cultural Contexts of Theological Texts

- Historical-critical method: overview and application.
- The socio-political context of the Old and New Testaments.
- Early church fathers and their contexts.
- Reformation and modern theological developments.
- Case studies: interpreting texts in their historical setting.

Day 3: Literary and Rhetorical Analysis of Theological Texts

- Literary genres and their conventions.
- Figures of speech: metaphor, simile, allegory, typology.
- Rhetorical analysis: ethos, pathos, logos.
- Narrative criticism: plot, character, setting.
- Practical exercises in literary analysis.

Day 4: Doctrinal and Systematic Theology: Frameworks for Interpretation

- Key doctrines: Trinity, Christology, soteriology, ecclesiology.
- Development of doctrine over time.
- Systematic theology: organisation and methods.
- How doctrine influences interpretation.
- Case studies: interpreting texts through doctrinal lenses.

Day 5: Contemporary Contexts and Contextual Theology

- What is contextual theology?
- Liberation theology: key figures and principles.
- Feminist theology: hermeneutics of suspicion.
- African theology: inculturation and Ubuntu.
- Practical application: interpreting a text from a contextual perspective.

Day 6: Integrating Theological Information into Ministry and Practice

- Preaching from a contextual perspective.
- Teaching theological concepts to diverse audiences.
- Pastoral care and theological reflection.
- Developing contextual Bible study guides.
- Group project: designing a theological application plan.

Day 7: Synthesis, Assessment, and Future Application

- Review of key concepts and methods.
- Final project presentations.
- Peer and facilitator feedback.
- Creating a personal action plan for ongoing theological engagement.

- Course evaluation and certification.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
