- Evaluate the effectiveness of different biblical approaches (e.g., Matthew 18, Philemon) in resolving conflicts.
- Design a reconciliation plan using scriptural principles for a given case study.
- Demonstrate empathy and active listening skills when facilitating reconciliation conversations.
- Implement strategies to sustain reconciled relationships and prevent future estrangement.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This training is designed for pastors, church leaders, counsellors, mediators, and anyone involved in community or organizational conflict resolution who seeks faith-based reconciliation frameworks.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations and Models of Biblical Reconciliation

- Introduction to the course and SAQA unit standard requirements.
- Biblical foundations: Shalom, covenant, and the ministry of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:18-20).
- Case study: Joseph and his brothers – stages of reconciliation.
- Case study: The prodigal son – repentance, forgiveness, and restoration.
- The role of the mediator and the Holy Spirit in reconciliation.
- Barriers to reconciliation: pride, unforgiveness, and systemic injustice.
- Practical application: Group exercise applying a model to a real-life scenario.
- Assessment and reflection on the day's learning.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **3 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
