COURSE OUTLINE

- Methods for identifying timeless principles vs. time-bound instructions.

- Group discussion: Challenges in interpreting texts across different cultures.

Day 2: Practical Application and Integration in Contemporary Contexts

- Applying biblical teachings on reconciliation in post-apartheid South Africa.
- Using Scripture to address social issues: poverty, inequality, and corruption.
- Role-play: Navigating ethical conflicts in the workplace using biblical wisdom.
- Developing a framework for contextual preaching and teaching.
- Workshop: Crafting a contemporary application from an Old Testament text.
- Peer review and feedback on application exercises.
- Creating a personal plan for integrating biblical texts into daily life.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
