COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of School Sanitation Planning

- Overview of school sanitation challenges in South Africa
- Legal and policy framework: SAQA, Department of Basic Education guidelines
- Stakeholder identification: learners, educators, parents, local government
- Participatory needs assessment methods
- Basic sanitation infrastructure types: toilets, handwashing stations, wastewater management
- Health and hygiene promotion: link between sanitation and disease prevention
- Introduction to project lifecycle for sanitation projects

Day 2: Designing and Implementing Sanitation Projects

- Project planning tools: Gantt charts, work breakdown structures
- Budgeting and cost estimation for sanitation infrastructure
- Technology selection: ventilated improved pit latrines, septic systems, waterless urinals
- Design considerations: accessibility, gender sensitivity, child-friendly features
- Procurement procedures and tender processes
- Contractor selection and supervision
- Monitoring and evaluation frameworks: indicators, data collection methods
- Risk management and contingency planning

Day 3: Sustainability, Maintenance, and Community Engagement

- Maintenance planning: schedules, spare parts, and budgeting
- Training school staff and learners on facility care
- Hygiene promotion strategies: handwashing campaigns, sanitation clubs
- Community engagement: school governing bodies, parent committees
- Behaviour change communication techniques
- Environmental sustainability: waste management and water conservation
- Reporting and documentation: project closure, lessons learned
- Handover procedures and post-implementation support
