- Group discussion: balancing personal beliefs with professional responsibilities.
- Reflection on practical application in daily life.

Day 3: Advanced Application and Community Impact

- Analysis of modern social issues: inequality, environmental stewardship, and peacebuilding.
- Case studies: individuals and organisations embodying Christ-like principles.
- Workshop: creating a community project proposal based on Christian values.
- Developing a personal action plan for ongoing spiritual and ethical growth.
- Presentation skills: articulating the relevance of teachings to diverse audiences.
- Peer feedback and refinement of action plans.
- Course summary and assessment of learning outcomes.
