COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Biblical Prophecy

- Introduction to biblical prophecy: nature, purpose, and types.
- Overview of prophetic books: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, and the Minor Prophets.
- Historical and cultural context of the prophets.
- Principles of interpretation: literal, symbolic, typological, and allegorical.
- Covenants and dispensational frameworks.
- Fulfilment patterns: immediate, near, and far fulfilment.
- Prophecy concerning Israel and the nations.
- Practical exercise: analysing a sample prophecy.

Day 2: Advanced Hermeneutics and Prophetic Genres

- Hermeneutical approaches: grammatical-historical, redemptive-historical, and canonical.
- Apocalyptic literature: Daniel and Revelation—symbols, visions, and time frames.
- Messianic prophecies: identification and fulfilment in Jesus Christ.
- Eschatological systems: premillennialism, amillennialism, postmillennialism.
- Prophecy and the church: the role of the Holy Spirit and spiritual gifts.
- Contemporary prophetic movements: evaluation and discernment.
- Case study: interpreting a complex prophetic passage.
- Group discussion: comparing interpretative frameworks.

Day 3: Practical Application and Integration of Prophecy

- Synthesis of prophetic themes: judgment, restoration, kingdom, and hope.
- Creating a prophetic study plan: resources, tools, and schedules.
- Prophecy and ethics: addressing social justice, suffering, and end-times ethics.
- Teaching and preaching prophecy: clarity, relevance, and pastoral sensitivity.
- Integrating prophecy with other biblical genres (law, wisdom, gospel).
- Prophecy and the future: personal application and community impact.
- Final project: outline a prophetic teaching series.
- Course review and assessment.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
