## COURSE OUTLINE

### Day 1: Foundations of Christian Worship Leadership

- Theology of worship: Old and New Testament perspectives.
- The role of the worship leader: servant leadership and pastoral care.
- Elements of worship: music, prayer, scripture reading, and response.
- Planning a worship service: selecting songs and structuring flow.
- Working with worship teams: communication and rehearsal techniques.
- Spiritual disciplines for worship leaders: prayer, devotion, and accountability.
- Cultural and contextual considerations in South African worship.
- Introduction to SAQA unit standard requirements.

### Day 2: Practical Application and Participation in Worship

- Leading congregational singing: techniques for engaging the congregation.
- Managing transitions: between songs, prayers, and other elements.
- Facilitating participation: encouraging response and inclusivity.
- Using technology and instruments effectively in worship.
- Troubleshooting common challenges in worship services.
- Peer feedback and self-evaluation after practical exercises.
- Creating a personal worship leadership development plan.
- Assessment and portfolio of evidence preparation.

## ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
