COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Personal and Corporate Salvation

- Introduction to salvation: personal vs corporate dimensions.
- Biblical foundations: Old and New Testament perspectives.
- The concept of shalom: holistic well-being and restoration.
- Individual transformation: repentance, faith, and new identity.
- Corporate salvation: covenant community and collective redemption.
- Case studies: historical examples of personal salvation leading to community impact.

Day 2: Practical Application for Individual and Community Transformation

- Spiritual disciplines: prayer, scripture, and community engagement.
- Overcoming personal strongholds: mindset and behavioural change.
- Community needs assessment: identifying areas for transformation.
- Models of community transformation: asset-based and participatory approaches.
- Building partnerships: church, civil society, and government.
- Ethical leadership and servant leadership principles.
- Case study: successful community transformation initiatives in South Africa.

Day 3: Integration, Assessment, and Action Planning

- Review and synthesis of key concepts from Days 1 and 2.
- Developing a personal transformation roadmap.
- Project planning: goals, resources, timelines, and evaluation.
- Monitoring and evaluation: measuring spiritual and social impact.
- Navigating challenges: resistance, sustainability, and scaling.
- Peer review and feedback on action plans.
- Commitment to lifelong learning and community engagement.
- Closing reflection and commissioning.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
