- Overview of South African emergency legislation (OHS Act, SANS standards).
- Types of emergencies: fires, chemical spills, medical emergencies, natural disasters.
- Emergency planning: risk assessment, resource allocation, roles and responsibilities.
- Communication protocols: alarms, emergency numbers, incident reporting.
- Evacuation procedures: assembly points, roll calls, special needs considerations.
- Basic first aid: CPR, bleeding control, shock management.
- Fire safety: use of extinguishers, fire prevention measures.
- Practical drill: tabletop exercise simulating a workplace emergency.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **2 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
