Day 1: Introduction to the DTI and its Mandate

- Key legislation: Companies Act, Consumer Protection Act, Competition Act, etc.
- DTIC structure: branches, agencies (e.g., CIPC, SABS, NCR, etc.).
- The role of the DTIC in industrial policy and economic growth.
- Stakeholder engagement: business, labour, and civil society.
- Case studies: impact of DTIC policies on local industries.

Day 2: DTIC Programmes and Practical Application

- Incentive programmes: SEDA, NEF, SEZ, etc.
- B-BBEE codes and the role of the DTIC.
- Export promotion and trade agreements.
- Compliance and enforcement: competition, consumer protection, and company registration.
- Practical workshop: completing a CIPC registration or B-BBEE scorecard.
- Group activity: case study analysis and presentation.
- Assessment and course wrap-up.
