COURSE OVERVIEW

This course provides learners with the foundational rules of Tajweed to ensure correct and beautiful recitation of the Quran. It covers articulation points, characteristics of letters, and key rules such as noon saakinah, meem saakinah, and madd. By mastering these principles, learners will enhance their ability to recite the Quran with accuracy and reverence.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Demonstrate correct pronunciation of Arabic letters from their proper articulation points (makharij).
- Apply the rules of noon saakinah and tanween, meem saakinah, and madd in recitation.
- Analyze and correct common recitation errors using Tajweed principles.
- Evaluate the characteristics (sifaat) of letters and their impact on recitation quality.
- Implement rhythmic and melodic aspects of recitation (tarteel) as per Tajweed guidelines.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for adult learners in South Africa who wish to improve their Quran recitation skills, including reverts, new Muslims, and those seeking to refresh their Tajweed knowledge.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Tajweed and Articulation Points

- Introduction to Tajweed: definition, history, and significance in South African context.
- The articulation points (Makharij al-Huruf): throat, tongue, lips, and nasal cavity.
- Characteristics of letters (Sifaat): permanent and occasional qualities.
- Rules of noon sakinah and tanween: izhar, idgham, iqlab, and ikhfa.
- Practical exercises: correct pronunciation of difficult letters (e.g., , ,).
- Common errors in recitation among South African learners.

Day 2: Advanced Rules and Melodic Application

- Rules of meem sakinah: idgham shafawi, ikhfa shafawi, izhar shafawi.
- Rules of lam sakinah: lam al-ta'rif and lam al-fi'l.
- Qalqalah: letters and application.
- Madd (prolongation): types (asli, far'i) and lengths.
- Waqf and ibtida: rules for stopping and resuming.
- Melodic recitation: applying maqamat in Tajweed context.
- Group practice: recitation of selected verses with focus on fluency.

Day 3: Integration, Review, and Assessment

- Comprehensive review of all rules covered.
- Recitation of Surah Al-Fatiha with full application of Tajweed.
- Recitation of selected short surahs (e.g., Al-Ikhlās, Al-Falaq, An-Nas).
- Peer feedback and error correction techniques.
- Simulated assessment: individual recitation with constructive evaluation.
- Strategies for continued practice and improvement post-training.
- Q&A; session and certification requirements.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 1**.
