COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips maintenance technicians with the skills to perform safe, efficient, and systematic maintenance on film wrapper packet infeed units. Participants will learn to diagnose common faults, replace worn components, and verify correct operation, minimising downtime and ensuring product quality.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Demonstrate safe isolation and lock-out/tag-out procedures for film wrapper packet infeed units.
- Apply systematic fault-finding techniques to diagnose infeed unit malfunctions.
- Implement preventive maintenance schedules for belts, guides, and sensors.
- Evaluate the condition of mechanical components and determine replacement needs.
- Adjust infeed timing and tension settings to meet packaging specifications.
- Document maintenance activities and report non-conformances according to standard operating procedures.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- Maintenance artisans, machine setters, and production technicians responsible for the upkeep of packaging machinery in food, beverage, or pharmaceutical manufacturing environments.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Film Wrapper Packet Infeed Unit and Basic Maintenance

- Overview of film wrapping process and infeed unit role.
- Key components: belts, rollers, sensors, guides, and drives.
- Safety procedures: lock-out/tag-out, PPE, and hazard identification.
- Routine maintenance: cleaning, lubrication, and tension checks.
- Troubleshooting common issues: jams, misalignment, and sensor faults.
- Documentation: maintenance logs and fault reporting.

Day 2: Advanced Maintenance, Troubleshooting, and Practical Application

- Advanced fault-finding techniques: electrical, mechanical, and pneumatic.
- Replacement of belts, rollers, and sensors.
- Alignment procedures for guides and infeed timing.
- Sensor calibration and verification.
- Practical hands-on session: simulated maintenance scenarios.
- Assessment and documentation per SAQA unit standard 117625.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
