- Implement lock-out/tag-out and other safety protocols to ensure a safe working environment.

- Pipeline operators, maintenance technicians, and supervisors responsible for the day-to-day operation and minor upkeep of pipeline equipment in the oil, gas, or water sectors.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Pipeline Equipment Minor Maintenance Procedures

- Overview of pipeline equipment: pumps, valves, actuators, and instruments
- Safety procedures: lockout/tagout, PPE, and hazard identification
- Routine inspection checklists and frequency
- Minor maintenance tasks: lubrication, seal replacement, and bolt tightening
- Troubleshooting common issues: leaks, vibrations, and pressure drops
- Tools and equipment for minor maintenance
- Documentation: maintenance logs, work orders, and incident reports
- Practical exercise: performing a minor maintenance procedure on a valve
