WHO SHOULD ATTEND

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Islamic Ethics and Conduct

- Introduction to Islamic ethics: scope and relevance.
- Key terminology: Akhlaq, Adab, Ihsan, Taqwa.
- Primary sources: Qur'anic verses on morality and Prophetic traditions (Hadith).
- Classical frameworks: Al-Ghazali's virtues and vices.
- The concept of niyyah (intention) and its ethical implications.
- Practical adab in daily interactions: family, neighbours, and community.
- Case study: Applying ethical principles to common workplace dilemmas.
- Group discussion: Identifying personal ethical strengths and areas for growth.

Day 2: Advanced Application and Integration of Islamic Ethics

- Ethical decision-making models based on maqasid al-shari'ah (objectives of Islamic law).
- Case studies: Honesty in business, confidentiality, and environmental stewardship.
- Adab in the digital age: online communication, privacy, and avoiding gossip.
- Leadership ethics: justice, consultation (shura), and humility.
- Overcoming common ethical challenges: anger, envy, and backbiting.
- The concept of tazkiyah (self-purification) and practical strategies.
- Role-play: Applying adab in conflict resolution.
- Personal action plan: Setting ethical goals and accountability measures.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
