WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This training is designed for construction workers, site supervisors, and artisans who use or oversee the use of small plant and equipment such as plate compactors, concrete mixers, and power tools on construction sites.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Small Plant and Equipment, Safety, and Basic Operation

- Overview of small plant and equipment: plate compactors, concrete mixers, small generators, and hand-held power tools
- Legal framework: OHS Act, relevant regulations, and manufacturer specifications
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) and site safety protocols
- Pre-operational checks: fuel, oil, water, and visual inspections
- Basic operational procedures: starting, stopping, and controlling equipment
- Routine maintenance tasks: cleaning, lubrication, and minor adjustments
- Fault reporting and record-keeping
- Practical exercise: safe operation of a plate compactor and concrete mixer

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 1**.
