WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is intended for rail workers, maintenance personnel, and supervisors involved in the operation and recovery of track bound units, including locomotive drivers, shunters, and track maintenance staff.

Day 1: Introduction to Track Bound Unit Operations

- Overview of SAQA unit standard 119100 and learning outcomes.
- Types of track bound units and their uses in rail operations.
- Safety regulations, PPE requirements, and hazard identification.
- Basic track layout and signalling principles.
- Communication procedures and hand signals.
- Pre-operational checks: visual inspection, controls, and systems.
- Emergency response: stopping, evacuating, and reporting incidents.
- Practical demonstration and assessment preparation.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
