COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills required to safely transport explosives and their accessories using rolling stock (railway vehicles) within the South African regulatory framework. It covers the classification, handling, and documentation of dangerous goods, as well as emergency response procedures. The course ensures compliance with relevant legislation and promotes a safety-first culture in the transport of hazardous materials.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply relevant legislation, regulations, and codes of practice governing the transport of explosives by rolling stock.
- Classify and identify explosive substances and accessories according to their hazard classes and compatibility groups.
- Implement safe loading, securing, and unloading procedures for explosives on rolling stock.
- Analyze documentation requirements, including dangerous goods declarations and transport emergency cards.
- Demonstrate emergency response procedures in the event of an incident involving explosives during rail transport.
- Evaluate risk factors and implement control measures to ensure safe transport operations.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for railway operators, logistics personnel, safety officers, and supervisors involved in the transportation of explosives and dangerous goods by rail.
- It is also suitable for individuals seeking to meet regulatory requirements for handling hazardous materials in the transport sector.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Transport of Explosives and Accessories by Rolling Stock

- Overview of relevant legislation: SANS 10228, National Road Traffic Act, and SAQA unit standard 119124.
- Classification of explosives: UN classes, compatibility groups, and segregation rules.
- Rolling stock requirements: specialized wagons, placarding, and securement methods.
- Safety procedures: pre-departure checks, en-route monitoring, and emergency response.
- Documentation: dangerous goods declaration, transport emergency card, and loading plans.
- Roles and responsibilities: shipper, carrier, driver, and consignee.
- Practical exercise: completing a dangerous goods declaration for a sample load.
- Assessment: written test on key concepts and procedures.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **2 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 1**.
