- Communication tools and platforms for network coordination.
- Roles and responsibilities within a network.
- Governance structures: steering committees, working groups, etc.
- Conflict resolution and decision-making processes.
- Monitoring and evaluation of network performance.
- Resource mobilisation and financial sustainability.

Day 3: Advanced Applications and Integration

- Linking networks to advocacy and policy influence.
- Digital networking: using social media, online communities, and virtual platforms.
- Inclusive networking: engaging marginalised groups and ensuring diversity.
- Ethical considerations: confidentiality, power dynamics, and accountability.
- Practical workshop: developing a network action plan.
- Presentation and peer feedback on network strategies.
- Course wrap-up and reflection on learning outcomes.
