COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Implementing Safety Procedures for Open Hole or Deep Excavations

- Legal framework: OHS Act, regulations for excavations.
- Competent person: definition, duties, appointment.
- Hazard identification: soil types, utility locations, environmental factors.
- Protective systems: sloping, shoring, shielding.
- Safe work procedures: access/egress, spoil placement, monitoring.
- Emergency planning: rescue, communication, first aid.
- Documentation: permits, inspection records, risk assessments.
- Practical exercise: case study and inspection simulation.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
