- Identify common poultry diseases and their causes, including viral, bacterial, and parasitic infections.
- Apply basic biosecurity measures to prevent disease introduction and spread on a poultry holding.
- Demonstrate correct procedures for vaccination, medication, and record-keeping in poultry health management.
- Analyze signs of ill health in poultry and implement appropriate initial responses.
- Evaluate the importance of nutrition, housing, and hygiene in maintaining poultry health.
- Implement a basic health management plan that includes preventive measures, monitoring, and reporting.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for poultry farm workers, small-scale poultry producers, and aspiring poultry entrepreneurs who need to understand and apply basic health management practices in their daily operations.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Poultry Health and Biosecurity

- Overview of poultry health management and its economic impact
- Common poultry diseases: symptoms, causes, and spread
- Biosecurity measures: farm access, disinfection, and isolation
- Assessing poultry health: behavioral and physical indicators
- Vaccination programs: types, schedules, and handling
- Record keeping for health monitoring

Day 2: Nutrition, Housing, and Environmental Management

- Poultry nutrition: feed types, additives, and feeding practices
- Housing design: space, ventilation, and lighting
- Environmental management: temperature, humidity, and litter quality
- Stress factors: overcrowding, poor air quality, and noise
- Waste management: manure handling and pest control
- Water quality and supply management

Day 3: Disease Prevention, Treatment, and Practical Application

- Disease treatment protocols: antibiotics, supportive care, and withdrawal periods
- First aid for injured or sick birds
- Emergency response: disease outbreaks and mortality disposal
- Developing a health management plan: steps and components
- Monitoring and evaluating health interventions
- Practical exercises: health assessment, vaccination technique, and record keeping
