COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Identifying Intervention Services and Providing Support to Child and Youth Victims of Abuse and Neglect

- Overview of child abuse and neglect: definitions, prevalence, and impact.
- Legal framework: Children's Act (No. 38 of 2005), Child Justice Act, and reporting obligations.
- Types of abuse: physical, emotional, sexual, and neglect – signs and indicators.
- Role of intervention services: social workers, child protection organisations, police, and healthcare.
- Referral pathways: how to connect victims with appropriate services (e.g., Childline, Thuthuzela Care Centres).
- Providing initial support: trauma-informed communication, safety planning, and emotional first aid.
- Documentation and reporting: maintaining confidentiality, completing forms, and legal requirements.
- Case study: applying knowledge to a realistic scenario of child abuse intervention.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 3**.
