COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Victim Assistance and Human Rights

- Introduction to victimology and the South African context
- Legal framework: Constitution, Bill of Rights, Victims' Charter, and relevant legislation
- Types of victimisation: crime, domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and human rights abuses
- Psychological and social impact of victimisation
- Principles of trauma-informed care and victim-centred approach
- Effective communication: active listening, empathy, and non-judgmental support
- Referral pathways and multi-sectoral collaboration (SAPS, social services, NGOs)
- Self-care for service providers and ethical considerations

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 3**.
