- Licensing and competency requirements for individuals involved in maintenance.
- Safe storage standards for firearms and ammunition (SABS/ISO standards).
- Procedures for temporary storage during maintenance.
- Record-keeping and documentation requirements.
- Penalties and legal implications for non-compliance.
- Case studies: Application of legislation in maintenance contexts.
