WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for maritime personnel, including seafarers, shore-based operators, and communication officers who are responsible for coordinating operations between vessels and land-based stations.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Shore-to-Sea Communications

- Overview of maritime communication regulations (ITU, SAQA, SAMSA).
- Introduction to communication equipment: VHF, MF/HF, satellite systems.
- GMDSS principles and sea areas.
- Standard Marine Communication Phrases (SMCP).
- Distress, urgency, and safety communications.
- Procedures for routine communications between shore and sea.
- Radio watchkeeping and logkeeping.
- Practical exercises: basic radio checks and call setup.

Day 2: Operational Communication Techniques and Scenarios

- Detailed procedures for distress alerts and safety calls.
- Search and Rescue (SAR) communications.
- Communication with port authorities and vessel traffic services (VTS).
- Handling medical advice and assistance requests.
- Use of digital selective calling (DSC).
- Practical drills: simulated distress scenarios.
- Troubleshooting common communication issues.
- Logging and reporting communications.

Day 3: Advanced Applications and Practical Integration

- Coordination with multiple shore stations and ships.
- Use of satellite communications and email systems.
- Communication during special operations (e.g., towing, pilotage).
- Electronic chart display and information systems (ECDIS) integration.
- Case studies of communication failures and lessons learned.
- Comprehensive practical assessment: scenario-based communication exercise.
- Review of key concepts and Q&A;
- Final assessment preparation and feedback.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
