COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundational Hazard Identification and Mitigation in Local Contexts

- Definition and classification of hazards (natural, technological, social).
- Local context assessment: physical environment, demographics, and infrastructure.
- Spatial impact analysis: mapping hazard zones and vulnerable areas.
- Social impact analysis: community vulnerability, displacement, and health risks.
- Mitigation strategies: engineering controls, land-use planning, and community awareness.
- Regulatory overview: OHS Act, SANS codes, and local by-laws.
- Case studies: common hazards in South African communities (e.g., flooding, fires, crime).
- Group activity: hazard identification walk-through and mitigation plan development.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **3 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 3**.
