- The court's discretion and the requirement of good cause
- Procedural steps: notice, affidavits, and service requirements
- Time frames and prescription considerations
- Practical examples of rescission and variation scenarios

Day 2: Procedural and Evidentiary Requirements

- Drafting formal notices of motion and founding affidavits
- Evidentiary burdens: establishing a prima facie defence or error
- Responding to opposing affidavits and replying
- Case law analysis: rescission of default judgments (e.g., Colyn v Tiger Food Industries)
- Variation applications: correcting patent errors and ambiguous orders
- Relationship between rescission and appeal procedures
- Effects of delay, acquiescence, and waiver
- Practical drafting exercise: preparing a rescission application

Day 3: Advanced Applications and Practical Integration

- Rescission of consent orders and judgments by agreement
- Variation in family law: maintenance orders and custody arrangements
- Rescission and variation in insolvency and liquidation proceedings
- Opposing applications: drafting answering affidavits and heads of argument
- Ethical issues: duty to court, full disclosure, and abuse of process
- Costs considerations and offers to settle
- Mock hearing: arguing a rescission application
- Assessment and feedback on practical exercises
