Day 2: Application and Integration of Airpower

- Joint operations: air-land, air-maritime, and air-special operations integration
- Airpower in asymmetric warfare and humanitarian assistance
- Emerging technologies: UAVs, cyber, and space integration
- Scenario-based planning and mission analysis
- Law of armed conflict, rules of engagement, and collateral damage mitigation
