COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Recovery Control Profiles and Mission Control Operations

- Introduction to recovery control profiles: definitions and applications.
- Overview of mission control systems and their operational context.
- Key data elements in a recovery control profile: parameters, thresholds, and sequences.
- The recovery lifecycle: detection, assessment, decision, and execution.
- Roles and responsibilities within a mission control team.
- Safety and compliance standards relevant to recovery operations.
- Practical exercise: interpreting a sample recovery control profile.

Day 2: Advanced Application and Practical Integration of Recovery Control Profiles

- Advanced analysis of recovery control profiles: anomaly detection and contingency planning.
- Simulation exercises: running recovery scenarios in a mission control environment.
- Decision-making under pressure: prioritising recovery actions.
- Post-recovery review: documenting outcomes and lessons learned.
- Integrating profiles into operational workflows and checklists.
- Troubleshooting common issues in recovery execution.
- Final assessment: practical case study and group debrief.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
