COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Community Health Assessment

- Key concepts: community, health determinants, and indicators.
- Stakeholder identification and engagement strategies.
- Ethical principles: informed consent, privacy, and cultural sensitivity.
- Overview of the assessment planning process.
- Data collection methods: surveys, interviews, focus groups, and observation.
- Introduction to South African health policies and frameworks (e.g., PHC, District Health System).
- Practical exercise: Identifying community health issues in a case study.
