COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills required to supervise and monitor home-based supervision and other rehabilitation programmes within the South African criminal justice and social development context. Learners will be able to plan, implement, and evaluate rehabilitation interventions in community settings, ensuring compliance with relevant legislation and ethical standards.

- Demonstrate an understanding of the principles and objectives of home-based supervision and rehabilitation programmes.
- Apply relevant legislation, policies, and procedures to the supervision and monitoring of offenders in the community.
- Design and implement supervision plans that address the criminogenic needs of offenders.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of rehabilitation interventions and adjust plans accordingly.
- Maintain accurate records and prepare reports on the progress of offenders under supervision.
- Demonstrate effective communication and interpersonal skills when interacting with offenders, families, and other stakeholders.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for probation officers, social workers, correctional officials, and community-based supervisors involved in the management of non-custodial sentences and rehabilitation programmes.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Home-Based Supervision and Rehabilitation

- Overview of the South African correctional system and relevant legislation (e.g., Correctional Services Act, White Paper on Corrections).
- Ethical considerations and professional conduct in supervision.
- Roles and responsibilities of the supervisor: monitoring, support, and accountability.
- Introduction to case management: assessment, planning, implementation, and review.
- Understanding offender profiles: risk factors, criminogenic needs, and responsivity.
- Basic communication skills: active listening, empathy, and motivational interviewing.
- Introduction to rehabilitation programmes: types, goals, and evidence-based practices.

Day 2: Monitoring, Reporting, and Rehabilitation Programme Implementation

- Monitoring tools and techniques: home visits, electronic monitoring, and collateral contacts.
- Reporting procedures: progress reports, violation reports, and court updates.
- Documentation standards: accuracy, confidentiality, and timeliness.
- Implementation of rehabilitation programmes: scheduling, resources, and facilitation.
- Adapting programmes for diverse populations: gender, culture, and special needs.
- Managing non-compliance: sanctions, incentives, and behaviour contracts.
- Crisis intervention and conflict resolution strategies.
- Collaboration with stakeholders: social workers, psychologists, police, and community organisations.

Day 3: Advanced Supervision, Evaluation, and Integration of Learning

- Evaluation methods: outcome measures, recidivism tracking, and feedback loops.
- Advanced case management: risk assessment tools, treatment planning, and relapse prevention.
- Special topics: substance abuse, mental health, and domestic violence.
- Role-play exercises: conducting home visits, handling violations, and facilitating group sessions.
- Case study analysis: multi-problem offenders and complex supervision scenarios.
- Self-care and professional boundaries for supervisors.
- Developing a personal action plan for ongoing professional development.
- Assessment of competence: practical demonstration and portfolio of evidence.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
