COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the principles and practices of risk management, enabling them to identify, assess, monitor, and mitigate risks within an organisational context. Participants will develop the ability to implement risk management processes aligned with relevant standards and frameworks, fostering a proactive risk culture.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply risk management principles to identify and classify risks in a workplace context.
- Analyse risk assessment techniques to evaluate the likelihood and impact of identified risks.
- Design risk monitoring and reporting mechanisms to track risk exposure and control effectiveness.
- Implement risk response strategies to mitigate, transfer, accept, or avoid risks.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of risk management processes and recommend improvements.
- Demonstrate compliance with relevant risk management standards and legislative requirements.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for managers, team leaders, risk officers, and professionals responsible for overseeing risk management activities within their organisations, particularly those in corporate or public sector environments.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Risk Management

- Introduction to risk management: definitions and concepts.
- Types of risks: strategic, operational, financial, compliance, reputational.
- The risk management process: establish context, identify, analyse, evaluate, treat, monitor and review.
- Risk appetite and risk tolerance.
- Legal and regulatory requirements for risk management in South Africa.
- Overview of ISO 31000 and COSO frameworks.
- Roles and responsibilities in risk management.

Day 2: Risk Assessment and Monitoring Techniques

- Risk identification tools: brainstorming, checklists, SWOT analysis.
- Risk analysis techniques: probability and impact matrix, bow-tie analysis.
- Qualitative vs quantitative risk assessment.
- Risk evaluation and prioritisation.
- Risk treatment options: avoid, reduce, transfer, accept.
- Developing risk treatment plans and controls.
- Key risk indicators (KRIs) and monitoring dashboards.
- Risk reporting structures and escalation procedures.

Day 3: Integrating Risk Management and Practical Application

- Building a risk management framework: policy, process, and governance.
- Creating and maintaining a risk register.
- Risk monitoring: periodic reviews, audits, and incident reporting.
- Continuous improvement: lessons learned and risk culture.
- Case study: risk management in a South African organisation.
- Group exercise: develop a risk management plan for a given scenario.
- Presentation of risk management plans and peer feedback.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
