- Hazard identification methods: inspections, observations, and checklists.
- Risk evaluation: likelihood, severity, and risk rating matrices.
- Documentation and reporting: risk registers and corrective action plans.
- Practical exercise: conducting a simulated risk assessment in a workplace scenario.
