Day 1: Introduction to Rope Access Team Supervision and Advanced Rescue

- Overview of rope access industry and supervisor duties
- Legal framework: OHS Act, SANS 10019, and SAQA unit standards
- Advanced rescue equipment: harnesses, ropes, connectors, and descent devices
- Risk assessment and hazard identification
- Incident reporting and emergency response planning

Day 2: Team Management and Rescue Planning

- Team coordination and communication protocols
- Rescue plan development: victim assessment, anchor selection, and route planning
- Mechanical advantage systems for rescue
- Advanced knots and anchor rigging
- Scenario-based planning exercises

Day 3: Supervised Practical Application and Assessment

- Supervisory oversight during rope access tasks
- Advanced rescue techniques: pick-offs, lowers, and highlines
- Post-rescue debrief and documentation
- Practical assessment of team supervision and rescue skills
- Final review and certification requirements

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
