- Demographic risk: age profile, chronic disease prevalence, and benefit design.
- Financial risk: investment performance, reserves, and underwriting cycles.
- Risk evaluation frameworks: quantitative and qualitative methods.
- Case study: analysing a fictional medical scheme's risk profile.
