- Key statutes: Occupational Health and Safety Act, Labour Relations Act, National Environmental Management Act, and Protection of Personal Information Act.
- Regulatory bodies: Department of Employment and Labour, National Nuclear Regulator, and Information Regulator.
- Legal risk identification and assessment methodologies.
- Case studies on legal risk scenarios and their management.
- Practical implications for risk management policies and procedures.
