COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Fundamentals of Asset in Transit Vehicle Operations

- Overview of asset in transit operations and relevant SAQA unit standards.
- Legal framework: National Road Traffic Act, dangerous goods regulations, and company policies.
- Roles and responsibilities: driver, loader, dispatcher, and security.
- Vehicle types and suitability for different assets.
- Load securing principles: weight distribution, tie-downs, and safety checks.
- Documentation: waybills, delivery notes, and incident reports.
- Communication protocols: radio, GPS, and emergency contacts.
- Risk assessment: theft, damage, accidents, and contingency planning.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **3 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
