- It is also suitable for security personnel involved in cargo protection.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Fundamentals of Cargo Management and Security

- Overview of SAQA Unit Standard 242834 and course outcomes.
- Regulatory framework: SACAA, IATA, ICAO, and local legislation.
- Cargo supply chain stakeholders: shippers, freight forwarders, airlines, ground handlers.
- Security threats: theft, tampering, sabotage, and smuggling.
- Cargo security measures: access control, screening, and sealing.
- Cargo handling procedures: acceptance, storage, loading, and transfer.
- Documentation: air waybills, manifests, and security declarations.
- Emergency procedures and incident reporting.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
